SPS “CARES” PROGRAM

Children Are Receiving Extended Services

Monday through Friday, Saint Patrick School (SPS) provides children enrolled in Saint Patrick School with parochial elementary school education and supplementary care in a Catholic environment. SPS “CARES” operates from 6:45am to 5:30pm.

The program allows children to experience a rich diversity of growth activities which are planned to complement the philosophy and value systems of the school and family. Computer fun, arts and craft projects, games and recreation, naps for younger children, and snack time are just a few of the planned activities. Time is also set aside for homework completion for grades 3 through 8. This program strives to provide individual attention, security, consistency and caring treatment for children. The CARES program is staffed by an experienced director, and a number of devoted and committed staff members. The staff works together to help each child develop and grow in self-respect.

Fees are the sole support of the CARES Program. It is not subsidized by the school or parish.

LUNCH PROGRAM

The school offers daily hot lunches. Students inform their teachers in the morning if they are purchasing a school lunch. Parents maintain a cafeteria account which is debited when lunches are bought. Cost per lunch is \$2.50. Students may bring lunch to school. Milk is available for purchase for .50. Water is available for .35 (8oz.) or .50 (16oz.) Ice-cream is available for purchase on Fridays.

PARENT/TEACHER/CHILD CONFERENCES

- Grades 7-8: 60 minutes







